- A copy of the brand inspection, record of sale or similar proof demonstrating the assessment has been paid must be submitted with this refund application.
- The applicant's name must be the same as it appears on the brand inspection, bill of sale or similar proof of payment.
- As required by law, all eligible refunds will be paid by the CCC within 60 days of receipt of a completed application and proof of payment.
- This application has been issued a unique identification number. Each application expires 90 days from date of issue and may not be duplicated at any time, nor will any application without a unique ID assigned by the CCC be accepted.

BY SIGNING BELOW, THE APPLICANT:

1. Certifies that all information provided in connection with this request for refund is true and correct.
2. Certifies that the applicant has paid the assessment for which applicant is now seeking a refund.
3. Certifies that the applicant has not previously submitted a similar request on some or all of the cattle covered by this request.
4. Certifies that the applicant, if submitting a refund using a Bureau of Livestock ID, has paid the invoice. The law requires the fee to be paid prior to the Council issuing a refund. Submitting an unpaid invoice from the Bureau of Livestock ID as proof of payment will delay and may prohibit the Council from fulfilling the refund request.
5. Acknowledges that any misrepresentation or false statements made in furtherance of this application will constitute grounds for denial of a refund.
6. Authorizes the CCC to conduct an audit by contacting the collection entity to verify the data underlying this refund request is valid, and authorizes collection entity personnel to disclose information regarding the underlying cattle transaction to the CCC or its agents.
7. Certifies the signatory is the rightful seller of the cattle and the request for refund is not being submitted by an agent, representative or collection entity.

As authorized by law, the CCC will work in conjunction with the California Department of Food & Agriculture and the Attorney General's Office to prosecute fraud or recover refunds made using false information.
